END OF THE YEAR REPORT CARDS

IMMUNIZATIONS & PHYSICALS

According to State Code, if a child does not present proof of health examination and immunizations by October 15 of a year in which proof is required, the school board is required to suspend the child from school.

May a school board establish a date earlier than October 15 for proof of immunization? Yes, provided the school district gives notice of the requirement at least 60 days prior to the established earlier date.

At the January 2015 board meeting, the board established the immunization deadline date for the 2015-2016 school year as the second day of student attendance. Therefore, 2015-2016 immunizations/physicals are due August 20, 2015.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

All financial obligations need to be met by Tuesday, May 26. This includes, but is not limited to lunch bills, registration, drivers education fees, etc.
