Registration Dates

Registration letters will be mailed the week of July 24. If you have not received your letter by July 31, please contact the district office at 217-392-2172. The registration process will be the same as last year. Registration materials will be found on the homepage of the district website (including school calendar, immunization requirements, and school supply list) starting July 24. All students grades pre-k through 12th grade will register at the junior/senior high in Augusta. Registration dates and times will be:

Opening Days of School

Open House will be Thursday, August 24 at the elementary from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and at the junior/senior high from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The first day of student attendance will be Friday, August 25. This will be a 2:05 p.m. dismissal.

Immunizations 2017-2018 (Next Year)

According to state law, every student must meet all vaccination requirements by October 15, 2017. According to state law, students who do not meet these requirements must be suspended from school. There are only two acceptable exceptions. The first acceptable exception is based on a medical reason. This must be written by a healthcare provider and it is through the Illinois Department of Health. The second acceptable exception is based on a religious reason. This must be written by a healthcare provider and it is through the Illinois Department of Health. Therefore, students will be suspended from school beginning October 16, 2017 unless they have: 1) provided proof of required immunizations, 2) provided written proof of medical exception through the IDPH, or 3) provided written proof of religious exception through the IDPH. Please take care of this. Thank you for your attention to this important legal requirement.

School Finances

The following information is based on the end of May 2017.

- 92% into the fiscal year.
- We have received 89% of our budgeted revenue. We have spent 90% of our budgeted expenditures.
- Our fiscal year fund balance is a negative \$71,622. Our overall fund balance is a positive \$2,658,338.
- Our monthly expenditures are usually around \$500,00 per month.
- The state owes us \$342,512.17.

Partial Abatement of Working Cash

At the June 26, 2017 board meeting, the board of education "approved the partial abatement up to \$410,210.50 from the Working Cash Fund to the Education and Transportation Funds." As of June 26, 2017, the state of Illinois owes us \$401,210.50. If the state would pay us the money they owe us, we would have a balanced budget for the 2016-2017 (like we did last year). However, because of this situation, we are forced to transfer money from working cash into two of our funds, education and transportation. The purpose of the working cash fund is to enable school districts to have in their treasury at all times sufficient money to meet demands for ordinary and necessary expenses. Because school revenue is not always received according to schedule, the working cash fund provides a school board with a source of internal borrowing to meet short-term needs and reduce the need to borrow from outside sources that bear interest costs. In other words, the working cash fund is our emergency fund or rainy day fund. We levy a nickel every year for this fund.
