Mrs. Akers' Report:

- Julie Bice, Title 1 teacher, lead an initiative for Hancock County elementary teachers to raise funds to send to teachers at Sandy Hook Elementary in Newtown, Connecticut. All seven Hancock County elementary schools participated. Southeastern raised \$166.28 and a total of \$453.12 was sent with a suggestion to do something special for the teachers who spent Christmas break attending funerals and setting up their classrooms in a different building.
- Fifth grader Isaac Weese and seventh grader Ben Janssen will be representing Southeastern at the Hancock County Spelling Bee on Tuesday, February 26th.
- Third through sixth grade teachers have been preparing their students for the upcoming ISAT's. Testing will begin on Monday, March 4th and continue through Friday, March 15th. Analysis of 2012 test data showed as much as a 20 point reduction in the percentage of students meeting/exceeding when new "cut scores" were applied.
