June Board Meeting Action Summary

Approved a cooperative agreement between Southeastern and Central in the sport of girls' basketball at the high school level for 2012-2013 and 2013-2014.

Approved a cooperative agreement between Southeastern and Central in the sport of wrestling at the high school and junior high levels for 2012-2013 and 2013-2014.

Approved the renewal agreement with the Worker's Compensation Self Insurance Trust for three years.

Physicals/Immunizations

It is important all physical, dental, and immunization requirements are met, and we have proper documentation prior to the start of school – August 21st. According to the Illinois State Code, if a child does not present proof of health examination and immunizations by October 15th of a year in which such proof is required, the school district is required to suspend the child from school. This will be enforced. Thank you for your understanding and attention to this matter.

Backpack Project

"Free backpacks with some of the school supplies needed in the Southeastern School District will be given out on Monday, August 6, 2012 from 4:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. at the Living Faith United Methodist Church in Bowen. The church is located across from the elementary school. All students from the Southeastern School District are welcome to come. There are no income guidelines. Immunizations for students entering K, 6th and 9th grades will be given by the Hancock County Health Dept. for a charge to be announced later. Students must schedule an appointment for the immunizations by contacting Donna Harrison at 217-842-5583. Parents need to bring their child's immunization record, an insurance card or medical card with them to the appointment. Free haircuts will be given during the above hours and may be scheduled by contacting Donna Harrison at 217-842-5583."

Physicals and Immunizations.

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PRE-SCHOOL

- Physical exam is required within twelve months prior to the beginning of the fall term.
- Documentation of immunizations required: DTP/DTaP – 4 doses; Polio – 3 or more doses; HIB vaccination between 15-59 months of age; MMR – 1 dose; Hepatitis B – series of 3; and 1 dose of Varicella (chicken pox) – 1 dose vaccination on or after the 1st birthday or documentation of prior disease.
- Lead screening – documentation of any previous test or physical statement that the test is not necessary based on screening questionnaire.

KINDERGARTEN

- Physical exam is required within twelve months prior to the beginning of the fall term.
- Documentation of immunizations required: DTP/DTaP – 4 or more doses, with the last booster on or after the 4th birthday; Polio – 4 or more doses of combination IPV/OPV, or 3 or more doses of all-IPV or all-OPV, with the last booster on or after the 4th birthday; HIB not required for children 5 years of age or older; MMR - 2 doses, with the first on or after the 1st birthday and the second dose no less than 4 weeks after the first dose; Hepatitis B – series of 3; Varicella (chicken pox) – 1 dose vaccination on or after the 1st birthday or documentation of prior disease.
- Dental exam is required within twelve months prior to the beginning of the fall term.
- Lead screening – documentation of any previous test or physical statement that the test is not necessary based on screening questionnaire.
- Vision exam is required. The required form will be in your registration packet.

SECOND GRADE

- Dental exam required within twelve months prior to the beginning of the fall term.

SIXTH GRADE

- Physical exam is required within twelve months prior to the beginning of the fall term.
- Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, with pertussis component for adolescent) – 1 dose required.
- All other immunizations as required for kindergarten (see above).
- Dental exam required within twelve months prior to the beginning of the fall term.

NINTH GRADE

- Physical exam is required within twelve months prior to the beginning of the fall term.
- Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, with pertussis component for adolescent) – 1 dose required.
- All other immunizations as required for kindergarten (see above).
