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School-Based Staff Mandated Trainings

- The following slides include links to trainings that all school-based staff (WTA staff, WESA staff, administrators, and any other staff members who come into contact with children during the day) are required to complete, either because of Massachusetts regulations or Wayland School Committee policy
- Please read all of the linked information, and then submit the survey on the final slide to verify your completion of the mandated trainings
- When clicking on a link, it is recommended that you open it in a new window
- All mandated trainings should be completed by October 1, 2022

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Conflict of Interest Law for Municipal Employees

- All staff members must review the conflict of interest law summary each year, per state regulations
- Click <u>the link here</u> to be taken to the website and read the entire summary
- You do NOT need to complete and print the Acknowledgement of Receipt



Conflict of Interest -- Online Training

- In addition to review the conflict of interest law summary, all new staff members must also complete the conflict of interest online training within their first 30 days of employment, per state regulations
- All other staff members must complete the <u>conflict of interest online</u> <u>training</u> every two years (in addition to reviewing the law summary every year), per state regulations -- please complete the training this year if you did not do so last year
- When you have finished the training (if you are a new employee or did not complete it last year), print the certificate of completion and give it to your principal or supervisor
- If using an older version of Google Chrome, you will need to allow Flash to run

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51A Mandated Reporter Training

- All staff members must complete the <u>51A mandated reporter online</u> training, per state regulations
- You will need to log in to complete the training:
 - If you have not completed the online training before, you will need to register
 - If you have completed the training before, you will use your email to log in (Note: You may have previously registered with the old wayland.k12.ma.us email, so try that first)
 - If you don't remember your password, use the Forgot Password link on the page -- our tech department does not have any control over this website
- You do not need to print a certificate after completing the training



Physical Restraint Training

- All staff members must complete DESE's online presentation on the Prevention of Physical Restraint and Requirements if Used
- Note: Each slide will require a wait time before moving on to the next slide, and some slides will require that you click on links before moving to the next slide



Bullying Prevention and Intervention

- All staff members must review excerpted information from the district's <u>Bullying Prevention and Intervention Plan</u> each year, per Wayland School Committee policy
- Staff members who are interested in reviewing the full Bullying and Intervention Plan can access it on the district website -- the full plan also includes district policy JICFB, which addresses bullying prevention
