FREE MEALS AVAILABLE TO ALL CHILDREN 18 YEARS AND UNDER

Bedford County Public Schools will provide free meals under the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Seamless Summer Option to all children 18 years of age and under during the 2021-2022 school year. If your child is attending school in person, breakfast and lunch will be provided at school each day at no cost. If your child is not attending school in person, there is an option to pick up meals each day at any of the Bedford County Public Schools. Pick up times and locations are listed below. Parents can pick up meals without the child being present.

Meals are available to all children including those learning in-person or virtually and regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability.

Meals will be provided, on a first come, first served basis at the following times and locations:
