IPad Cases Need to Stay Clean!



Students should not be writing on or placing stickers on the iPad cases. Families could be billed for the replacement of the iPad case if the case is covered in writing, damaged by writing, covered in stickers, or otherwise defaced. *** Please keep in mind that the iPad case is the property of EACS, and needs to be kept clean.



Pop-Up Blocker Prevent Cross-Site Tracking

There are two settings within the iPad that can cause quite a few problems with many apps and programs. Follow these steps to ensure these settings are not enabled on your student's iPad: Go to Settings > Safari > Turn off the Pop-Up Blocker and "Prevent Cross-Site Tracking."



Skyward Student Profile

Have you recently moved or gotten a new phone number? In Skyward Family Access, guardians can view the information on file for their students.

To view, click on Student Profile on your dashboard. "Your Family Information" is the contact information on file. While there, also check the "Emergency Contacts" information as well. If anything needs changed, contact your student's school and they can assist you.



Stick to HTTPS websites

Here's something you may have never stopped to consider. Look up at the address bar of your browser: the URL begins with "https".

This means that unlike HTTP protocol websites, the site you're currently on uses a secure protocol, and all communication between your browser and that site is encrypted. In other words, no third party can eavesdrop on you and intercept the data you provide that site.

That's not to say that all HTTP websites are malicious, but it's always best to proceed with caution.
