IN THE NEWS:

- **New Haven High School's** band performed at the ISSMA prelims at Homestead High School and came away with their highest score yet. They received a bronze rating.

- **Paul Harding Junior High School** staff and students who each week pack backpacks with food for the Boomerang Backpacks program. Their custodian then transports the backpacks to Southwick Elementary School for distribution to the students who participate in this program.
- **Woodlan High School's** FFA recently hosted 480 area 2nd grade students for the annual Wabash/Erie demonstration, and their annual chili supper for 160 guests.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

The following projects are generally completed except for their associated punch lists: Cedarville Elementary; Heritage/Leo Outbuildings; Leo Elementary; Paul Harding Junior High/East Allen University; Southwick; and Woodlan. No Escrow/Retainage has been released for any of these projects.

New Haven High School - Renovations/Additions

The installation of exterior face brick for the auxiliary gym and kitchen storage is complete. A major portion of the new side walk and curb in front of the administration addition has been laid. Current schedule is by the end of this month EACS can move into the new administration/secure entrance addition. In the new administration addition, the office doors have been hung and the installation of carpet is almost complete. In the new main entrance vestibule, the damages from the ruptured line are being corrected by Hagerman and currently Hagerman is preparing the floor for the install of the terrazzo flooring. In the new classroom addition the door frames have been installed, the painting of classroom walls is in process, and the installation of the ceiling grid is in process. A meeting has been scheduled with Hagerman for next week to review the updated project schedule.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The west wall of the gymnasium is above six feet on finished floor. Brick is being laid on the north wall of the Mezzanine (Unit B) approximately 50% complete. The air and vapor barrier has been installed on the south and west walls of the classroom addition (Unit C). The roof joists on Unit C have been installed from the east end to the center stairwells. The roof deck on Unit C is approximately 15% complete. The installation of the roof drains and piping in the kitchen/cafeteria is 75% complete. The footing for the retaining wall is over 50% complete and the pouring of the retaining wall next to SR930 is in process. In the next two weeks the west wall of the gymnasium is to be complete along with the retaining wall.
