IN THE NEWS:

- **East Allen Alternative School** continues its Kindness Challenge. The yards of two local residents have been raked and six more yards are scheduled for raking this month.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

New Haven High School - Renovations/Additions

Work has started on the install of the exterior metal siding on the north side of the building above the administration/secure entrance addition. EACS received the occupancy permit for the administration/secure entrance addition, the plan is to remove the temporary barrier and have staff relocated so that the office area and new secure entrance is operational Monday. The Nurse has been relocated to the new area. In the classroom addition first floor: the classrooms have been painted, ceiling grid installed, restrooms tile laid, started installation of classroom cabinets, and the final section of terrazzo flooring to be poured is the south corridor. In the classroom addition second floor: classrooms painted, ceiling grid installed, terrazzo flooring has been poured and the southern portion of the corridor needs to be grind. The elevator has been installed. In the auxiliary gym: the walls have received at least their first coat of paint and the ceiling is currently being painted.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

Masonry work continues throughout the project: south and east load bearing walls of the administration area (Unit A); north side of Unit B; non-load bearing (interior) walls in the classroom addition (Unit C). Work continues on waterproofing the installed block. The roofer completed the roof above the Kitchen/Cafeteria and has started on the classroom addition (Unit C). The install of the overhead piping along with the electrical rough-ins in the kitchen/cafeteria continues. Work continues on the footing for the retaining wall and the retaining wall next to SR930 is more than 50% complete (poured more than 300 feet long).
