CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

New Haven High School - Renovations/Additions

In the former high school administration area the ceiling grids have been installed in the new classrooms. In the auxiliary gym area: the aux gym flooring has been installed and striped; in the locker room corridor the ceiling grid and exit doors were installed; in the aux gym corridor the ceiling grid has been installed, terrazzo flooring ground/polished and vestibule doors installed; and athletic offices painted. In the 2nd floor classroom renovation area: removed hallway lockers, classroom flooring, classroom ceiling grids, classroom white/chalk boards, science room student cabinets, and movable classroom wall dividers; demolition of doorways for the required classroom door alcoves has started; and the ceiling grid, partitions and fixtures in the restrooms have been removed.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The east half of the corridor slab in Unit A was poured. The remaining masonry exterior walls to be installed have been tented so that the laying of face brick on the eastern half (north and south) of the building continues. The framing of the bulkheads on the 2nd floor of Unit C (classroom addition) is in process. Fetters completed the installation of the ceiling grids in Unit C 1st floor classrooms, have started on the 2nd floor classrooms and the kitchen/cafeteria. They have started the installation of the visual display boards (i.e. whiteboards) in the Unit C 1st floor classrooms. Casework for the Unit C classrooms has been delivered, distributed to the classrooms and started to be installed. Fetters has started the installation of drywall on the locker bulkheads on the 2nd floor corridor of Unit C. The laying of quarry tile in the kitchen area is in process. The drywall in the office area has been installed. They have started the installation of the sprinkler piping in Units A & B. The chiller has been set on the pad. The painting of the boiler room and mezzanine in Unit B is in process.
