IN THE NEWS:

- **Cedarville Elementary School** has achieved 4-Star School status for the 13th consecutive year! They are 1 of only 13 K-12 (1 of 4 in elementary) schools from both public and non-public in all of Allen County who earned this status.
- **Heritage Elementary School** 2nd graders attended "AESOP's Fables" at PFW performed by Tennessee Theater. Students got to see The Lion and Mouse, The Dog in the Manger, Tortoise and the Hare, and The Ants and the Grasshopper as well as to learn all about Aesop himself.
- **Leo Elementary School's** three Robotics teams competed at the Indiana VEX Robotics Championship at Lucas Oil Stadium on Saturday, March 9. Our three teams placed 1st, 2nd, and 4th in their divisions, with each team winning the Design Award and qualifying for the VEX World Championship in April.
- **New Haven Primary School** celebrated Read Across America Week with fun spirit days and special guest readers for our favorite Dr. Seuss books.
- **New Haven Intermediate School** has been recognized for being 1 of 37 schools in the state who has successfully launched Project Lead the Way.
- **Prince Chapman Academy's** Math Bowl team placed 3rd in the recent local Math Bowl competition; overall placing 11th out of 32 with other Fort Wayne schools who participated.
- **Southwick Elementary School** was selected as a top 10 national finalist for the Middle School Kindness Challenge.
- **Woodlan Elementary School** 3rd grade students were able to video chat with Mr. Jared Strautman, an electrical engineer. They were able to hear about his job and ask him questions about what it takes to be an engineer.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

New Haven High School - Renovations/Additions

In the new classrooms in the prior high school administration area: the flooring, cabinets, and doors have been installed, and starting to install vinyl coping base. The auxiliary gym area is ready to turn over to the school with the outstanding items to complete: the display cases in the corridor. In the 2nd floor classroom renovation areas: masonry work has started on the student restrooms classrooms are starting to be painted.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The laying of face brick on the eastern half (north and south exterior walls) of the building continues along with the face brick on the kitchen/cafeteria. Started installing the precast window sills where the face brick is complete with window installation to follow in Units A & B. The north corridor of Unit C has been prepped for the terrazzo and they have started pouring it. Started the installation of ceramic tile in student restrooms on the 1st and 2nd floors of Unit C. Started the installation of the stainless steel counters in the kitchen area. Started to install light fixtures in Unit C 1st and 2nd floor classrooms. The installation of the visual display boards (i.e. whiteboards) in the Unit C 1st floor classrooms is complete and have started on the 2nd floor classrooms. Installation of casework for the Unit C classrooms continues. Started to install casework in the music room. The quarry tile in the kitchen area has been laid and grouted. Work continues on the installation of the sprinkler piping in Units A & B.
