### NEW HAVEN PRIMARY SCHOOL

- New Haven Primary School is a Pre-K through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade school, serving approximately 500 students in the New Haven attendance area.
- NHPS prides themselves on providing a welcoming, safe, and nurturing environment for their students, specializing in early educational development and establishing the foundation for lifelong learning.
- Their highly effective instructional staff have high expectations for all students so they can flourish.
- Strong standards-based core curriculum with additional interventions are provided through the RtI process.
- NHPS utilizes the Positive Behavior Intervention & Supports (PBIS) framework. Under the PBIS umbrella, instructional time is more effective and the school climate is more conducive to learning.
- The 8-Step school improvement model analyzes student data and provides all students with a 30-minute Success Time devoted to re-teaching and enrichment.
- Their school-wide reading program promotes reading the entire school year. Students read books to earn prizes from Pizza Hut.
- They offer a sensory room and Bulldog Trail, promoting sensory simulation for input and output of all 7 senses.
- Facebook Live events are held from time to time for families to view and participate in.
- Mindset Mondays that support students with building character traits such as Courage and Perseverance.
- Clubs/extracurriculars offered include Glitter Cheer and intramurals.
- NHPS hosts Project READS after school.
- During the summer Kindergarten Countdown is held.
- NHPS is committed to safety through the usage of the Safe Visitor System and A.L.I.C.E. protocol for emergency situations.
