## SPOTLIGHT ON

### CEDARVILLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- Cedarville Elementary School (CEEL) has a tradition of excellence because of the unified commitment by students, families, and staff members. Strong community relations are fostered. 800+ students attend the school in grades kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, with 32 classroom teachers and additional support staff including Art, Music, Physical Education, Speech, Resource, Counseling, RtI Specialist, and Special Needs.
- CEEL's instructional program incorporates Daily Five reading, 6 + 1 Writing Traits and Daily Math Review into the daily curriculum at all grade levels, and all literacy lessons support learning the five critical aspects of reading.
- CEEL has a computer lab with twenty-eight stations, and a STEAM room where students use technology to integrate science, technology, engineering, art, and math skills. It also has networked computers, 1:1 student iPads, and Smart Technology in each classroom.
- CEEL is a 2014 and 2020 National Blue Ribbon Exemplary High Performing School, and is currently the only elementary school in northeast Indiana rated "exceeds expectations" through the Federal School Accountability system.
- For the past 15 years, CEEL has been recognized as a 4-Star School, and an A-rated school (every year the recognition) by the Indiana Department of Education.
- A dynamic PTO organizes and sponsors a school carnival, spirit wear sales, Friday popcorn/pretzel days, parent classroom helpers, classroom parties, the Harlem Wizards basketball event, and a school Book Fair.
