Rolls-Royce, the legendary luxury car company, is working on building small modular reactors, and are a step closer to construction after the British government asked the Office for Nuclear Regulation to begin the approval process for the project. The British government hopes the SMRs will reduce the country's dependence on fossil fuels, insulating the UK from future gas market shocks and reducing emissions in line with its target for net zero carbon emissions by 2050.
