Clarinet history

The clarinet evolved from the chalumeau, a name to describe a woodwind . This instrument was used in many musical works, all the way up until the 18th century. The chalumeau is also the ancestor of the oboe. As the clarinet players among our readers will know, the clarinet's lower register is called the chalumeau!

How a b flat clarinet works?

Clarinets have reeds in their mouthpieces. When the clarinetist pushes air over the reed, it begins vibrating. The speed and size of vibrations produced is controlled by covering and uncovering holes in the tube .



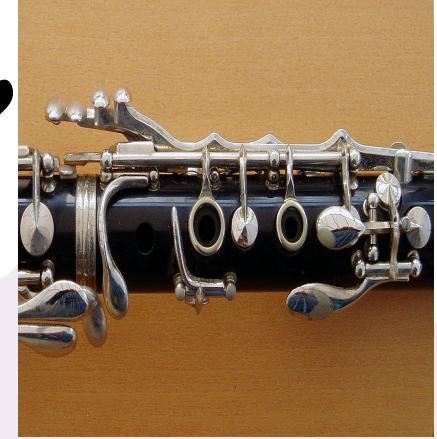
Benny goodman!

Was one of the first musicians to have an interacial band . This was groundbreaking not only in the music industry but for the world in general.

Benny Goodman's 1938 Carnegie Hall performance which was unlike any other before . Jazz was brought to the main stage through the collaboration of black and white musicians playing together to create a historical performance and recording. Just like black and white keys on a piano, the black and white musicians played together in perfect harmony.
