

Boys Tested in Quinter

The Golden Plains Bulldogs tested their skills in Quinter coming home with a first and second place in events at the Quinter Invitational on May 2.

With 17 teams competing, Zach Spresser triple jumped into a first place finish with a jump of 42' 0.5". Placing second was Tristan Schwarz with a personal best throw of 45' 5.75" in shot put. Schwarz also placed 6<sup>th</sup> in discus with a throw of 129' 4".

Cole Ziegelmeier rounded out the scoring as he ran the 3200m 12:00.77, a personal best, for a sixth place finish. Many of the boys set personal bests in their events (marked with an \*). Additional results are listed below.
