

Boys Improve at Quinter

The Golden Plains Middle School boys' track team competed at the Quinter Invitational on May 2. "All grades competed in one division at this meet," said Coach Russ Aumiller. "Although we didn't have a lot of boys place, several posted improved times and distances."

Seventh grader AJ Camacho improved his time in the 100m dash as he placed second with a 12.46 run. Eighth grader Devin Carter also showed improvement as he decreased his time to 1:06.89 in the 400m run for sixth place. He has increased his distance in the discus throw at each meet and threw 100' 9" for fifth place in Quinter. This extended his distance from the previous meet by over 4 feet. Distance runner Clayton Bange cut 38 seconds off his time in the 3200m run as he finished in 2nd place with a time of 12:30.10. Additional results are listed below.
