

Sixth Grade Girls Score in Logan

Each sixth grade girl competing in the Logan Invitational Track Meet on May 8 put up points for Golden Plains Middle School to earn the second place spot in the meet.

Mabel Lugo led the team in points by placing first in each event she competed in. She ran the 100m for the first time winning the gold with a time of 14.74. She placed first in the 400m run with a time of 1:12.40 and first in the 800m run finishing in 2:58.48. Lugo also ran with the older girls in the 4 x 200m relay for the junior high division for a first place finish.

Taryn Fleckenstein added team points in her events by placing 5th in the 800m run (3:18.72), 5th in shot put with a season best 24' 6.75", 3rd in discus with another personal record of 55'5", and 2nd in the 4 x 100m relay along with Sable Finlay, Jaiden Koerperich, and Karri Schaben (1:07.11).

Koerperich placed 3rd in the 200m dash running for the first time at 33.83 and Schaben placed 4th with a season best run of 34.10. Malilah Green finished up the team scoring with a 2nd place finish in the 100m hurdles (21.68).
