

MS Boys compete at the Northern Valley meet

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team placed 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall at the Northern Valley track meet in Logan on April 17. Track season is halfway through for the middle school but they aren't giving up yet.

Both relay teams placed with the 4x100m team of Clayton Bange, Devin Carter, Jeron Schutte and Caleb Korte placing 6<sup>th</sup> with a time of 1:00.57. The 4x200 consisting of Devin Carter, AJ Camacho, Jacob Ritter, and Dylan Spresser placed 2<sup>nd</sup> with a time of 1:58. The medley team of Jeron Schutte, Caleb Korte, Jacob Ritter and Dylan Spresser got 4<sup>th</sup> place with the time of 2:13.74.

As for individual events, Clayton Bange got 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 1600m run with a time of 5:51.37. Devin Carter placed 4<sup>th</sup> in discus with a throw of 96'4" and also got 5<sup>th</sup> in the 400m run with a time of 1:08.55. Jeron Schutte got 1<sup>st</sup> place in shot put with a throw of 35'3.75". AJ Camacho placed first in both the 100m run with the time of 12.87 and in the 800m with a time of 2:34.4 and got 2<sup>nd</sup> in long jump with 15'1". Jacob Ritter placed 1<sup>st</sup> in the 100m hurdles with a time of 18.52 and placed 6<sup>th</sup> in long jump with 13'6.75". Dylan Spresser placed 4<sup>th</sup> in triple jump with 30'1.5".

The sixth grade competed separately at this meet and also performed well. Bryce Tar Haar got 4<sup>th</sup> in shot put with 23'7", 6<sup>th</sup> in discus with a 54'10" throw, and 5<sup>th</sup> in 100m run with a time of 15.92. Colby Lathrop placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the 400m with a time of 1:20.11.

The middle school teams will attend their next meet on Friday May 1<sup>st</sup> at the Quinter Invitational. "It is going to be a really tough meet because both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> are combined" said AJ Camacho.
