

Bulldogs Play Hard in Weskan

The Golden Plains Bulldogs continued to work hard to improve their game as they played in Weskan on December 19 for their final game before the Winter Break.

The boys scored six points from Koi Wessel in the first quarter as they fell behind 6-9 to the Coyotes. Determined to improve their game, they added another 11 in the second with seven coming from the free throw line.

Trailing by 10 at the half, the Bulldogs stepped up their defense in the third to hold the Coyotes to three points while putting in 7 points of their own. They added another 10 in the fourth, but the Coyotes broke loose for 19 to win the game 49-34.

Koi Wessel led off with 14 points for the Bulldogs, including six free shots. Kade Wessel added 8 along with Brett Gerbitz-4, Devin Carter-4, Nick Brown-2, and Cole Ziegelmeier-2.

The JV squad played two quarters earlier in the evening. The Bulldogs put in six points in the first quarter of play with two baskets from Carter and two free throws from Jeron Schutte along with a three from Gerbitz in the second. The Coyotes outscored them 26-9 for the win.
