

JV Boys Drop Two on the Road

The Golden Plains JV Boys lost two road games last week as they fell 18-46 to Triplains/Brewster in Winona on February 17, then handed a three quarter game to Wheatland Grinnell 10-38 on February 20.

The boys led the Triplains/Brewster Titans 7-4 at the end of the first quarter on Tuesday, but were unable to score in the second as the Titans surged past for a 23-7 lead at the half. They found the basket a few times in the second half, but it wasn't enough as the Titans continued to outscore them for the 18-46 win.
