

Lady Bulldogs Overcome Coyotes By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs easily overcame the Lady Coyotes on the court in Weskan on December 19. The girls hit the floor in the first quarter and quickly grabbed a 19-6 lead in the first quarter.

The Lady 'Dogs continued to control the game in the second adding another 18 while holding the Lady Coyotes to 4 giving them a solid 37-10 lead at the half.

With such a commanding lead, the Lady 'Dogs rested some of the more experienced players in the second half and allowed the younger girls an opportunity to gain experience on the court. The Lady 'Dogs played with intensity and extended their lead to 47-15 by the end of the third. Both teams put in two points in the fourth to finish the game with another Bulldog win 49-17.

The Lady Bulldogs game is defined in their statistics from the game. Several girls posted up points including Gabrielle Schiltz-12, Kynndra Rush-12, Maddy Walz-10, Amber Erwin-7, Kami Miller-6, and Ana Bermudez-2. In addition to outscoring the Lady Coyotes, the Lady 'Dogs pulled down 26 rebounds to the Lady Coyotes 16. The girls also held their turnovers to 15 while the Lady Coyotes turned the ball over 28 times. The Lady 'Dogs worked as a team for 14 assists and played aggressively on defense for 13 steals. They also played a clean game with only 7 team fouls for the entire 32 minutes.

This last win before the Christmas break gives the Lady Bulldogs a season record of 4-1 and undefeated in league play. They will return to the court when they host two games the first week back in January. Triplains/Brewster will visit on January 9 and St. Francis will play in Rexford on Saturday, January 10.
