

MS Boys Compete Twice in Week

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team competed in their second track meet of the week in Logan at the Northern Valley Invitational on April 12. The 7th/8th grade boys competed together to score 64 points for third place behind Thunder Ridge and Logan. "Everyone is doing well," said BJ Rogers-8th grade. "It was fun to have two meets in the same week."

Eighth grader Roberto Loya scored 30 of the Bulldogs points by placing first in the 1600m run (5:39.14) and first in the 800m run (2:33.76). He also placed third in the 400m run (1:03.43) and fourth in the 100m dash (13.32).

Alex Gonzalez-8th grade also performed well placing third in triple jump (32' 3"), fifth in long jump (14' 6.5"), sixth in the 200m hurdles (34.34) and was a member of the first place 800m Medley relay team along with Garrett Carter, Fabian Cepeda, and Jovanny Infante with a time of 2:02.21.

The 800m relay team of Cepeda, Jesus Monge, Wyatt McDonald, and Infante placed third (2:09.59) and the 4 x 100m relay team placed fifth with a time of 1:04.59 run by Joshua Yanez-Perez, Carter, Ashton Schiltz, and McDonald.

Cepeda also ran the 800m in 2:48.84 for fifth place and Monge placed fourth in the 1600m run with a time of 6:56.40. Rounding out points for the Bulldogs was Ashton Schiltz with sixth place in shot put with a 31' 8.25" throw.

The boys' meet in Tribune has been cancelled twice due to winter weather so they will compete in Atwood again on April 19.
