

Bulldogs Face Off in Quinter

Ashton Schiltz put in 4 points and claimed 4 rebounds along with 5 points from Kole Butts. Butts also had 1 rebound, 1 assist, and 1 steal. Roberto Loya added 2 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists, and 1 block along with 2 points and 1 deflection from Ethan Weiner.
