

GP Lady Bulldogs Conquer the Huskies By Ashley Stoll

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs defeated the Northern Valley Huskies 54-26 on Friday, February 19, in Rexford to continue their undefeated season.

GPHS began the night with a strong start. They jumped ahead on the scoreboard with 4 points each from Kassie Miller, Brooke Stoll and Ashley Stoll and a basket by Carli Nieman to end the first quarter 14-4. The Dogs continued moving the ball in the second quarter. Three's from Breanna Rath, Brooke Stoll, and Ashley Stoll, along with baskets from Kassie Miller led the Dogs to add 20 more. They held Northern Valley to 10, heading into half time with a 34-14 lead.

The Bulldogs came out of half time with continued intensity. They put in 14 more, while containing the Huskies to 6 in the third quarter for a 48-20 lead. The Huskies and Dogs both added 6 more on the scoreboard to finish the game. The Dogs secured the win over Northern Valley 54-26. The Bulldogs advance to 18-0 on the season and will continue their season on Monday, February 22 as they travel to Leoti to take on Wichita County for the second time this season.
