

Lady Bulldogs Defeat Quinter By Carli Nieman

The GP Lady Bulldogs came home with another win 36-26 after traveling to Quinter to take on the Lady Bulldogs on January 26. This was the first matchup between both Lady Bulldogs.

GP was very determined when they stepped onto the court to start the game. The girls worked well in the first quarter battling the Bulldogs, ending the quarter with a 7-9 Quinter lead. Playing into the second quarter, GP continued to work hard on the defensive end. They finished the quarter only allowing Quinter to score 3 points while GP added 12 of their own for a 19-12 half time lead.

GP came out of the locker room fired up and continued to play strong after halftime, keeping their lead through the third quarter 26-20. Quinter was determined to not go down without a fight and stuck with Golden Plains until the end of the fourth quarter ending the game with a GP win 36-26.

The Quinter girls outrebounded the GP girls 32-28 with GP rebounds captured by Morgan Wark 11, Ashley Stoll 7, Kassie Miller 6, Brooke Stoll 3 and Breanna Rath 1.

Assists came from Wark 3, Rath 2, Miller 2, and A. Stoll 1. Miller had 5 steals along with Rath 3, B. Stoll 3, Wark 2, and A. Stoll 1. The girls also extended their record to 10-0 and will play the Cheylin Cougars in Rexford on January 29.
