

GP Girls Defeat The Titans By Ashley Stoll

The Golden Plains Varsity Lady Bulldogs hosted the Triplains/Brewster Titans on Tuesday, January 19. The Dogs had conquered the Titans once before this season in the Sagebrush Shootout. GP was able to take down Triplains/Brewster for the 2nd time, 70-12.

The Dogs stepped onto the court ready to play. They jumped out ahead from the start putting in 20 points in the first quarter. They had tough defense to go along with the offensive start and held the Titans to only 2 points. The Dogs didn't let up in the second quarter and added 21 more points to go into half-time leading the Titans 41-6.

The Bulldogs increased the intensity returning from halftime to add 22 more points in the third quarter. They were able to play strong defense and hold Triplains/Brewster to only 4 more, entering the fourth quarter on top 63-10. The Dogs continued the aggressive defensive battle and held the Titans to only one basket in the fourth quarter. They were able to add 7 more to triumph over the Titans 70-12.

Brooke Stoll led on the scoreboard with 18 along with Ashley Stoll with 17. Kassie Miller added 12 and Breanna Rath 10 more. Jordyn Fleckenstein contributed 7, Morgan Wark 4, and Rayna Taylor 2.

The Bulldogs outrebounded the Titans 43-21 with Ashley Stoll pulling down 12. Carli Nieman grabbed 7, Miller 5, Jordyn Fleckenstein 5, Rayna Taylor 4, Emma Weiner 3, Brooke Stoll 3, Morgan Wark 3, and Rath 1. They worked as a team with Brooke Stoll and Ashley Stoll each passing 4 assists. Rath and R. Taylor each had 3, Wark 2, Fleckenstein and Amie Cheney 1 each.

The Dogs aggressive defense was evidenced by the number of steals coming from Rath 4, A. Stoll 4, Fleckenstein 3, B. Stoll 1, Nieman 1, and Lauren Patmon 1. The Bulldogs will continue their season on Friday, January 22, by travelling to Brewster to take on the Titans for a third time.
