

Lady Bulldogs Continue Win Streak By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs continued their undefeated 16-0 season with a 57-29 win over Wheatland/Grinnell in Grainfield on February 12.

The Bulldogs jumped to a 19-6 lead in the first quarter. The Hawks fought back a bit in the second quarter to put in 10 points. The Dogs held strong to add 14 for a 33-16 half time lead.

The third quarter was all Bulldogs as they continued to play tough defense. The Dogs put in 22 while holding the Hawks to a single point. The Dogs finished the game with 2 in the fourth as the Hawks added 12 for the 57-29 Bulldog win.

Golden Plains senior Ashley Stoll went off for a career high 23 against the Hawks. "I appreciate the help of my teammates in stealing the ball and passing ahead or driving in and pitching out to get me an open shot," said Ashley. Brooke Stoll added 11 and Kassie Miller 10. Breanna Rath and Rayna Taylor each added 4, Sidney Taylor 3, and Morgan Wark 2.

The Lady Dogs pulled down 26 rebounds and had 16 assists—8 from Kassie Miller, 3 from Ashley Stoll, 2 from Brooke Stoll, and 1 each by Rayna Taylor, Carli Nieman, and Morgan Wark. The controlled the court with 17 steals—Miller 5, A. Stoll 4, Nieman 3, R. Taylor 2, B. Stoll 2, and S. Taylor 1.

"I thought we've adjusted well after a rocky start and hope to continue our success on the season as we are about to head into Sub-State," added Ashley Stoll. The Lady Dogs will continue their season with a postponed game against Rawlins County in Atwood on February 18.
