

JV Boy Host Titans

The Golden Plains JV boys basketball team played a full game against the Triplains/Brewster Titans in Rexford on January 19. The Bulldogs scored 3 points in the first quarter all from Ethan Weiner ending the quarter trailing 3-15. The Dogs added 7 more in the second quarter from Weiner and Ethan Shea while the Titans added 8, ending the half 10-23 in favor of the Titans.

The Bulldogs came back from halftime ready to play and spread the ball around the floor, adding 11 points from Weiner, Shea, Fabian Cepeda, Mason Green, Landon Meier and Tayten Barnett. Their defense allowed the Titans to put in 14, ending the third quarter 22-37.
