

JV Boys Fall to Titans By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains JV Boys basketball team fell to the Triplains/Brewster Titans in Brewster 30-56 on January 22 in Brewster. This was their second loss to the Titans in the same week after losing to them in Rexford the previous Tuesday.
