

Bulldogs Fall to Ringnecks

The Golden Plains High School boys basketball team suffered a 17-80 loss to the Hill City Ringnecks in Hill City on February 8.

The Bulldogs were only able to score 2 points in the entire first quarter with a basket by senior Ashton Schiltz while the Ringnecks opened the game with 28.
