

Bulldogs Fall to Trojans on the Road By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Boys varsity basketball team fell to the Logan/Palco Trojans 31-73 in Logan on January 14. The Trojans were 4-4 coming into the contest while the Dogs were 1-5.

The Trojans got off to a great start as they pumped in 20 points in the first quarter to the Bulldog 7. The continued to push hard in the second adding 25 while holding the Dogs to 6 giving the Trojans a 45-13 half time lead.

The Dogs never gave up as they worked for 12 in the third quarter—with 11 coming from senior Fabian Cepeda. The Trojans extended their lead to 62-25 with 17 third quarter points. The Trojans added another 11 in the fourth with the Dogs putting up 6 for the 73-31 final score.

Assists came from Cepeda 4, Gonzalez 2, Schiltz 1, and Shea 1. Ethan Weiner, Schiltz, and Shea each had a steal, Cepeda, Schiltz, and Rath each had a deflection and Gonzalez a block. The Bulldogs will play their next game at home against Triplains/Brewster on Friday, January 21.
