

## Quinter Wins Bulldog Battle

The Golden Plains Bulldog basketball team hosted the Quinter Bulldog basketball team in a make up game in Rexford on February 17. The Quinter boys claimed the victory with a 68-22 win over Golden Plains.

Senior Ethan Shea hit the first shot of the game for GP. Quinter quickly answered and went on a 10 point run before the GP team added three free throws from seniors Ashton Schiltz and Roberto Loya. Quinter hit a three, but Schiltz made another basket to end the quarter with Quinter leading 13-7.

Quinter controlled the second quarter extending their lead to 37-7 as Schiltz scored the only basket of the quarter with just over 2 minutes until the half. Quinter held the lead 39-9 at the break.

Quinter opened the third with 11, but Golden Plains was not out as Schiltz pushed in 4 from beneath the basket and Shea added a 3. Quinter maintained the lead 61-20 with 8 minutes to play. With the clock running in the fourth, Schiltz added one more basket for the home team as Quinter claimed the win 68-22.

Schiltz finished the game with a career-high 15 points while Shea added 5 and Loya 2. Schiltz also had a career-high 15 rebounds, 3 deflections, and 1 block. Additional rebounds were claimed by Shea 4, Loya 4, Josh Rath 2, Will Bruggeman 2, Fabian Cepeda 1, Owen Patmon 1, and Abe Taylor 1.

Assists were handed out by Ethan Weiner 2, Cepeda, Loya, Shea, and Taylor 1 each. Weiner also had 2 deflections along with Loya 2, and Cepeda, Shea, Patmon, and Bruggeman with 1 each. Patmon had 2 steals with Weiner, Loya, and Shea each grabbing 1. Garrett Carter had 2 block and Cepeda 1.

The Bulldogs finished the week by traveling to Almena to play Northern Valley on February 18.
