

## Lady Dogs Win Low-Scoring Game By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs continue to win as they defeated the Hill City Ringnecks in a low-scoring game 27-18 in Hill City on February 8.

The Lady Dogs opened the game with a 9-1 lead over the Ringnecks. Both teams played strong defense as the Lady Bulldogs added 8 in the second allowing the Ringnecks 4.
