

Lady Bulldogs Continue Winning Season in Almena By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldog basketball team continued their winning season with a 50-23 win over the Huskies on Northern Valley in Almena on February 18.

The Dogs never trailed the Huskies although the first quarter was close 8-6. Morgan Wark hit six in a row to start the second quarter before the Huskies could make a basket. Kassie Miller added four of her own to give the Bulldogs an 18-10 half time advantage.

Both teams continued to stay close in the third with the Bulldogs putting up 15 to the Huskie 11 with Miller hitting most of the shots along with baskets from Wark and Carli Nieman. The Dogs opened the game up in the fourth as they pumped in another 17 while their defense wore the Huskies down only allowing 2 giving Golden Plains their 18th win of the season 50-23.

Kassie Miller led the Bulldogs with a matching career-high of 27 points with 21 of them coming in the second half. Wark added 10, Anette Hernandez 5, Carli Nieman 4, Lauren Patmon 2, and Breanna Rath 2.

Wark pulled down 9 rebounds for the Bulldogs along with 7 from Nieman, Hernandez 6, Miller 5, Jordyn Fleckenstein 4, Sidney Taylor 3, Patmon 2, Amie Cheney 2, Rath led the Bulldogs with 4 assists with 2 each from Miller and Wark, and 1 by Nieman. Miller also grabbed 5 steals with 2 each from Rath, Nieman, and Wark.

The Lady Bulldogs played their final game of the regular season in Wallace County on February 22 receiving a bye for the first round of sub-state.
