

Lady Bulldogs Open Season with a Win By Rayna Taylor

The GPHS Lady Bulldogs started off their season at home against the Weskan Coyotes on December 3rd in Rexford. "It felt great to get back on the court with our season opener," said senior Kassie Miller. "We played very well together no matter the five on the court."

The Lady Bulldogs held the Coyotes to 10 points in the first quarter with the score ending 13-10. The Coyotes came in strong putting up 7 points early in the second quarter but fell behind ending the half 26-17.

The Lady Bulldog pulled through and put up 14 points in the third quarter while holding the Coyotes at 2. The Coyotes added 9 in the fourth quarter while Golden Plains finished with 8 winning the game 48-28. "It was a good way to start our season," said senior Carli Nieman. "We still have things to work and improve on."

Golden Plains was led in scoring by Rayna Taylor with 14 points, followed by Miller with 10. Miller had 6 steals and 5 assists. Rath had 3 steals and 4 assists. Nieman had 1 steal and 1 assist. Sidney Taylor had 2 steals. Wark had 3 assists, and Rayna Taylor had 1 steal.

The girls will travel to Brewster to compete in the Sagebrush Shootout on December 7 and will face the Heartland Christian Crusaders in their opening game.
