

JV Boys Win Half Game By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains JV boys basketball team won a 2 quarter game 15-12 over the Western Plains/Healy Bobcats on December 17 in Ransom.

Freshman Dominic Stout tipped the ball for the Bulldogs but the Bobcats made the first basket of the game. A score by freshman Josh Rath tied the game up. The Bobcats added a free throw, but Rath answered with one of his own. A basket from senior Ethan Shea gave the Dogs the lead before the Bobcats tied the game up at 5 at the end of the first.

In the second quarter, Will Bruggeman scored for the Dogs lead. The Bobcats answered and gained a slight lead. Jose Mendoza then regained the Bulldog lead. Rath and Mendoza each scored once more giving the Dogs a 3 point lead. The Bobcats narrowed the spread but two free throws from Shea at the end of the game gave the Bulldogs the 15-12 win.
