

JV Girls Play First Game By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldog JV basketball team played their first game of the season against Wichita County in Rexford on January 4. The girls played a two-quarter game with the Bulldogs winning 25-13 over the Indians.

The Bulldogs opened the game with two free throws from sophomore Jordyn Fleckenstein. They continued to hold a 6-0 lead with additional baskets by freshmen Hayden Wark and Anette Hernandez.
