

Lady Dogs Set Scoring Record By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs hosted Bethune, Colorado, in Rexford on January 22. This was the first time these two teams had played each other. The Dogs maintained their dominance on the court as they defeated the Bobcats 87-20.

Although the Lady Bulldogs had scored 76 on Healy in 2016 and 77 on Wilson at the state tournament in 2013, the last time the Lady Bulldogs had scored that many points in a single game was in 2009 when they scored 84 on Wallace County early in the season then posted 94 against the Wildcats later in the season.

The Dogs jumped to an early 19-0 lead to start the game before the Bobcats got on the boards ending the first quarter 21-7. The Dogs continued to rule the court with 29 added in the second while the Bobcats made 2 for a 50-9 half time score.

The Bobcats added another 7 in the third but the Dogs stayed strong with an additional 26. The Bulldogs posted a final 11 in the fourth holding the Bobcats to 4 for the 87-20 victory.

“I’m proud of how our team is working together,” said junior Sidney Taylor. “It was good that we were able to make our shots and that so many team members were able to contribute on both offense and defense. We will continue to work together to maintain our undefeated season.”

Kassie Miller led the team with 21 points. Sidney Taylor added 18 along with Morgan Wark 14, Jordyn Fleckenstein 8, Hayden Wark 6, Anette Hernandez 6, Breanna Rath 5, Rayna Taylor 5, and Lauren Patmon 4.

M. Wark had 8 rebounds while Hernandez Miller each had 6. S. Taylor pulled down 5, R. Taylor 4, H. Wark 3, Fleckenstein 3, Rath 2, and Amie Cheney 1. Assists were dished out by Rath 6, Miller 6, Patmon 4, M. Wark 3, S. Taylor 1, and Cheney 1. Steals were snatched by Rath 5, Miller 3, S. Taylor 2, Hernandez 1, and M. Wark 1.

Although the Lady Dogs were scheduled to host Quinter the following Tuesday, the game was postponed due to weather so they will enter the WKLL Tournament in Colby as they play Triplains/Brewster in the quarter-finals on February 1.
