

Bulldogs Score in St. Francis

The Golden Plains High School boys track team continues to improve as they scored 39 points for fourth place at the St. Francis Invitational on April 26.

Senior Ethan Weiner won the 3200m run with a time of 11:22.07 and Ashton Schiltz set a season-best/career-best throw of 120' 1" in Javelin for third place. Also placing third was the 4 x 800m relay team of Weiner, Ethan Shea, Alex Gonzalez, and Landon Meier with a 9:38.35 run.

Several events placed fourth including Gonzalez-Triple Jump 37' 8", Meier-1600m run 5:42.86, and Meier-3200m 12:40.02. Jose Mendoza set a PR of 58.91 in the 400m for fifth place and Schiltz set a PR of 39' 6.5" in Shot Put for fifth.

Sixth place points were awarded to Owen Patmon-1600m 6:11.20, and the 4 x 400m relay team of Gonzalez, Shea, Weiner, and Mendoza 4:12.77. Shea missed out on points with a 7th place finish in the 300m Hurdles with a 51.83 run.

Josh Rath set a PR in both the Triple Jump (33' 11.5") and 200m (30.62), Garrett Carter set a PR of 109' 7" in Discus, and Will Bruggeman set a PR of 29' 2" in Shot Put.

Additional field results include: Long Jump-Shea 15' 11", Rath 15' 8", Discus-Schiltz 91' 0", Bruggeman 85' 7", Wyatt Amlong 83' 4", Javelin-Abe Taylor 69' 6", BJ Rogers 68' 6", Brandon Luna 43' '0", Shot Put-Carter 33' 3", Rogers 24' 11.5".
