

Lady Bulldogs Finish Regular Season By McKinzie Horobik

The Golden Plains Middle School Girls Basketball A-team girls defeated the Weskan Coyotes 28-13 in the final game of the regular season in Rexford on Thursday, February 3.

The Dogs came ready to play and put up 7 in the first quarter. The girls kept the Coyotes from scoring. The Bulldogs were only able to score 3 in the second. Weskan was determined to make a lead, putting in 9, but the Dogs held the lead 10-9 at halftime.

Each team added 2 in the third, but the Dogs were on fire in the fourth as they finished with 16 holding the Coyotes to 2 for the 28-13 win.
