

MS Boys Score in Colby

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team scored well at the Colby Invitational Track Meet on May 6. The sixth and seventh grade boys combined for a total of 32 points for fifth place while the eighth grade boys, with only four team members, posted 69 points for third place.

The eighth grade boys had several first place finishes including Dylan Wark who won the 100m hurdles at 17.21, the 200m hurdles at 29.46, and the 800m at 2:24.35. Wark also tied for sixth in high jump at 4' 8". Diego Perez set a PR of 5:23.08 in 1600m for first place and won Triple Jump with a 35' 10.5" leap. He placed fourth in Long Jump at 16' 0.5" and fourth in 400m at 1:01.85.

Tanner Black set a PR of 13.67 in 100m for sixth place, placed fourth in Triple Jump at 30' 3.5", Long Jumped 12' 4.5" and ran the 400m in 1:08.29. Ezekiel Weiner set a PR of 13:11.48 in the 3200m run for fourth place and placed fifth in the 1600m run at 6:27.77.

In the seventh grade division, Roberto Araux set a PR of 59.66 in the 400m for first. He also placed second in the 100m hurdles at 19.04, third in the 200m hurdles at 34.01, and fourth in the 200m with a PR of 27.25. The 4 x 100m Relay team of Tanner Todd, Cristian Garcia, Javier Romero, and Owen Amlong finished fourth with a PR time of 1:13.65.

Additional results include: 100m-Garcia 17.58 (PR), Todd 18.14, Amlong 18.62; Long Jump-Todd 8' 9", Amlong 7' 1"; Shot Put-Garcia 21' 5", Romero 20' 8", Todd 18' 4"; Discus-Garcia 47' 11.5", Amlong 40' 1.5". The boys will finish their season at the WKLL meet on May 12 in Logan.
