

MS girls placed Third in Atwood

The Golden Plains Middle Schools girls competed in the second track meet of the season at Rawlins County on April 24. All grades (6th,7th, and 8th) were combined. The Lady Bulldogs placed third with 88 points.

Adilyn Meier took home first in the 800m with a time of 2:49.38 and second in the 1600m with a time of 6:17.11. She was also a member of the second place 4x400m relay with Anais Cepeda, Elizabeth Weiner, and Brenlynn Rath. "It was a little harder to compete with the 8th and 7th graders," said Meier. "We improved from the first meet. I had lots of fun and when I'm not competing I like to hangout with my friends."

Brenlynn Rath placed 5th in the 100 meters with a time of 15.02 seconds and 4th in the 200 meter with a time of 31.28 seconds. Elizabeth Weiner placed 2nd in the 800m with a time of 3:03.59 and 3rd in the 1600m running a 6:35.9. Anais Cepeda placed 5th in the 800 meter with a time of 3:11.22. The 4x200 relay team included Laura Moore, Marisol Perez, Katie Cater, and Addy Wessel placing 6th with the time of 2:26.92.
