

MS Girls Finish Fourth at League By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School Lady Bulldog track team competed in the WKLL League Meet placing fourth overall with 83 points in some close competition.

Sixth grader Adilyn Meier claimed an individual league championship in the 1600m run with a 6:30.22 run. Eighth grader Anais Cepeda claimed the #2 spot in the 1600m at 7:05.64. Seventh grader Addy Wessel finished sixth at 7:36.51.

Meier placed third in 800m at 2:48.13 and was a member of the third place Medley Relay team along with Elizabeth Weiner, Anais Cepeda, and Mayte Hernandez running a 2:18.42. The 4 x 200m Relay team placed second with the fastest time of the season at 2:11.90 with A. Wessel, Laura Moore, Evelyn Ortiz, and Hernandez running the laps.

Brenlynn Rath, sixth grade, won the league championship at 34.10 in the 200m hurdles running them for the first time this season. She placed third in 100m Hurdles at 18.80, set a PR of 31' 10" in Triple Jump for second place, and placed third in Long Jump with a PR of 14' 0.75".

Elizabeth Weiner placed second in the 3200m run at 13:54.30 and finished sixth in 800m at 3:02.70. Cepeda placed fifth in Triple Jump with a PR jump of 26' 10" and Kadalen Unrein set a PR of 38.30 in 200m hurdles for sixth. The 4 x 100m relay team of Lakin Wark, Briella Knowles, Estella Vargas, and Braylee Knowles placed fifth with a 1:05.81 run.

Briella Knowles just missed out on points as she placed 7th in 3200m (18:19.60) and Wark set a PR of 20.20 in 100m hurdles for 7th while Kailee Wessel finished 8th with a PR of 20.40. Additional PR's were set by Katie Carter in 200m (34.70) and Evelyn Ortiz in Shot Put (22' 8.25").

Wessel 90' 2", Weiner 84' 4", Perez 74' 4".

The middle school girls will graduate three eighth graders on to the high school team but will return a strong core of sixth and seventh graders for next season.
