

MS Girls Drop Two at Home By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School Volleyball teams lost two games each on their home floor on September 20 with losses to both Decatur Community and Rawlins County.

The A-Team played Rawlins County two sets. The Lady Buffaloes won the first set 25-14 and the second set 13-25. The Decatur Community games were closer with the girls from Oberlin winning the first set 25-19. The Lady Dogs came out in the second set with renewed determination.
