Minutes of Meeting
August 24, 2018

The Golden Plains Booster Club met on August 24, following the fall sports scrimmage, at the football field in Rexford. Members in attendance included Tia Carter, Judy Rogers, Tammy Miller, Nicole Schiltz, Stephanie Ritter, Dez Wark, Chachi Ochoa, Mandy Focke, and Jennifer Spresser

Judy reported the Booster Club has a balance of around \$8000. This does not include proceeds from the 2018 Thomas County Fair Concessions and does include a \$743 donation from the Class of 2018.

In old business, it was decided to purchase a Gatorade/Candy Bar for students who helped in the Thomas County Fair Concession Stand in July. Discussion was held regarding changes for next year and everything seemed to be ok as is.

Thank you cards for graduation gifts have been received from Maggi Nieman and Clayton Bange.

Under new business election of officers was held. 2018-2018 officers include Tia Carter-president, Jennifer Spresser-vice president, Judy Rogers-secretary/treasurer.

The members agreed to the following:

- Purchase a bottle filler/water fountain for the MS Locker Room area using funds donated by the Class of 2018 for this purpose and to pay the balance beyond the donation. Judy will take care of getting this ordered.
- Pay for ad for the Golden Plains page in the Sheridan Sentinel and the Hoxie Times if requested.
- Provide hot dogs etc for Homecoming Bonfire
- Provide a \$5 snack card for each high school student at the beginning of December
- Book the Prom DJ for Post Prom Virtual Reality game at a cost of \$350.

Discussion was held as to the request by Open Spaces Sports to sponsor coverage of Volleyball/Basketball/Track Tournaments, Regionals, Sub-State, and State at an annual rate of \$750. It was decided to pass this year and reconsider next year.

Discussion was held as to the request brought by Tia Carter to build a wind guard on the north side of the west gym door to protect those grilling for the concession stand during basketball season. Tia Carter will speak to Superintendent Keller to see what would need to be done to make this type of structural change to the building.
