Directions:

Write a newspaper article about an event you participated in over the summer. Use the information below to plan your article. The article should be a minimum of three paragraphs and be word processed.

Planning:

1. What event do I want to write about?
2. When was the event held?
3. Who was involved in the event?
4. Where was the event held?
5. Why was the event held?
6. How did the event go? What were the outcomes of the event?
7. Quotes from participants—

Writing

Headline: (Short attention getting statement about the event/include noun/verb)

Byline: (Who wrote the story)

Lead Paragraph: (include ALL the who/what/where/when/why/how)

Explanation Paragraph (s): (other facts/details that reader might want to know. Answer any important questions and include quotes)

Additional Information/Closing: any additional information regarding the event. What is the significance of event/what happens now/what's next?
