Staff Dress Code

Teachers and other staff members project an image to the community and to students about the professionalism of the district. During the workday and at all work-related activities, employees shall adhere to a professional standard of dress and shall be neat and clean in appearance. The principal has the final authority to decide what is professional attire.

Unacceptable items include any items deemed disruptive to the classroom environment or to the maintenance of a safe and orderly school, and any item which would be considered a violation of the student dress code.

Exceptions include appropriate athletic clothing may be worn when teaching or assisting with physical education classes, or when coaching athletic activities.
