IN THE MATTER OF

Support of Military Families and Purple Star School application

WHEREAS, today over one million Americans are bravely serving in the United States Armed Services. More than 219,000 Californians serve their nation in either an active duty, reserve, or national guard capacity; and

WHEREAS, over 136,000 children in the State of California are members of military families; and

WHEREAS, students who have parents in the military may experience unique challenges as a result of their family's military service including attending multiple schools; and

WHEREAS, frequent moves, family separations through deployments and reintegration which can cause academic difficulties for youth; and

WHEREAS, the Central Union Elementary School District is committed to meeting the unique needs of all students, especially those of military youth.

WHEREAS, the California Purple Star School Designation Program (Purple Star Program) was designed to help mitigate the challenges of high mobility by setting standards for and publicly recognizing military-friendly schools which support military-connected families

WHEREAS, the Central Union Elementary School District maintains a supportive and collaborative relationship with the command of Naval Air Station Lemoore; and

WHEREAS, the Central Union Elementary School District supports student and family transitions and communication, by maintaining a dedicated page on school websites with military connected information, assisting with student transitions at the school site via programs such as 'Anchored 4 Life' and Deployment clubs.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees ("Board") of the Central Union Elementary School District offers our gratitude and support for all military personnel, their families and veterans.





BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board affirms its commitment to support our military families and is dedicated to make all reasonable efforts to provide resources and programs, which could benefit students and families academically, socially, and emotionally; and, that the Central Union Elementary School District shall continue to develop programming to ease the

burden of service for military families by both raising the level of understanding and support by the staff members of this district and continuing to celebrate military service within our community.
