

**RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTING THE EDUCATION PROTECTION ACCOUNT**  
**Resolution Number 15-19/20**

WHEREAS, the voters approved Proposition 30 on November 6, 2012 and Proposition 55 on November 8, 2016, which created the Education Protection Account;

WHEREAS, a community college district, county office of education, school district, or charter school shall have the sole authority to determine how the monies received from the Education Protection Account are spent in the school or schools within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the monies received from the Education Protection Account shall not be used for salaries or benefits for administrators or any other administrative costs;

WHEREAS, the governing board of the district shall make the spending determinations with respect to monies received from the Education Protection Account in open session of a public meeting of the governing board;

WHEREAS, each community college district, county office of education, school district and charter school shall annually publish on its Internet website an accounting of how much money was received from the Education Protection Account and how that money was spent;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 2020-2021 moneys received from the Education Protection Account shall be spent as required by Article XIII, Section 36 of the California Constitution, in the following manner:

Ceres Unified School District and Whitmore Charter School will be allocating the use of Proposition 30 and Proposition 55 funds for expenditures on teacher salaries and benefits.

**THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION** was introduced at a regular meeting of the CERES UNIFIED BOARD OF TRUSTEES held on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, by Board of Trustees Member Wigt, who made the motion, which motion being duly seconded by de la Porte, was upon roll call, carried into Resolution and passed by the following vote:


